It is gradually becoming a tradition that the Czechs are bringing a number of stalls with Czech products to the Christmas market.

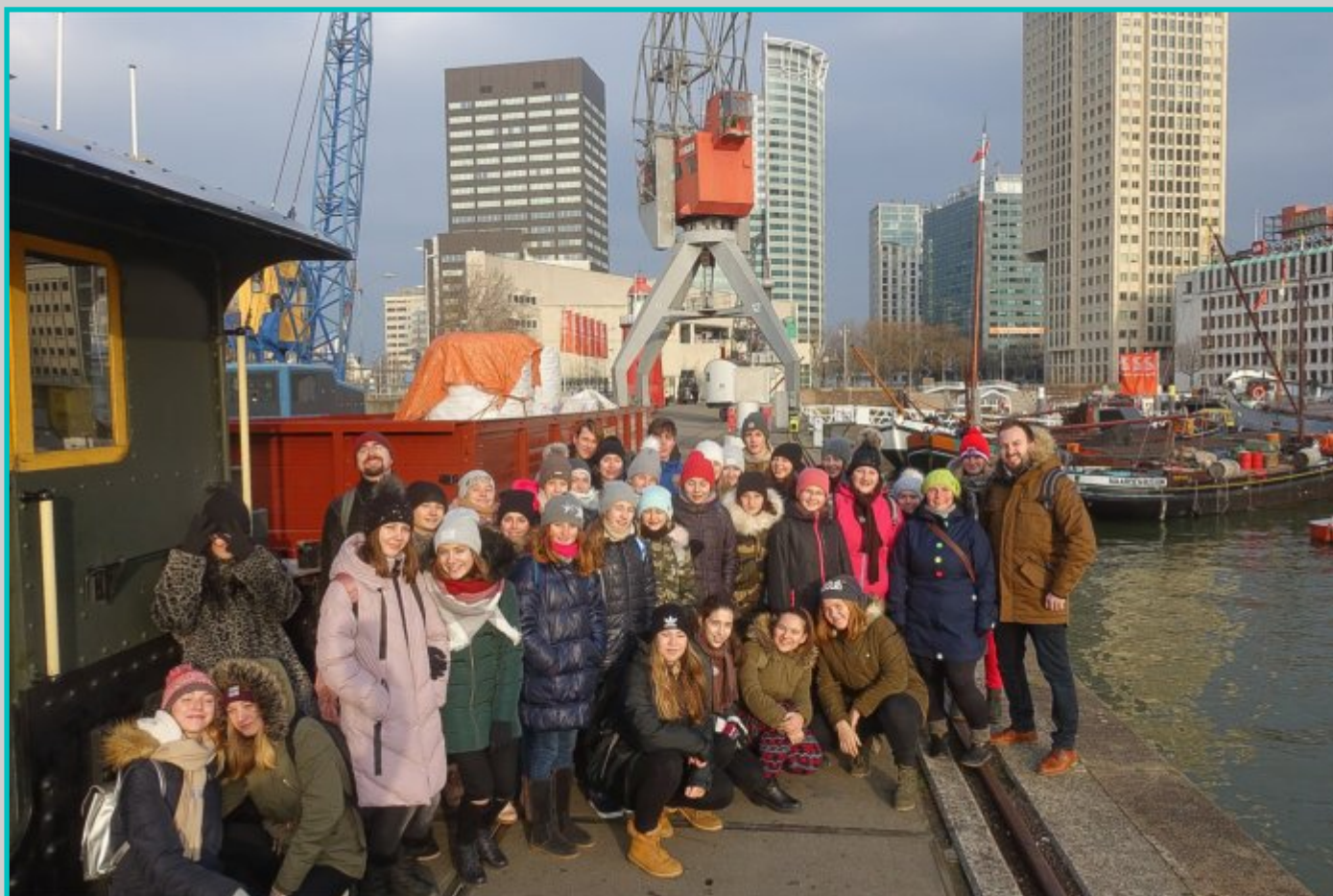


The road trip of OŘÍŠEK.
